

Apprenticeship Certificate Claim Form

The Apprenticeships, Skills, Children and Learning Act 2009 came into force in Wales on 24th June 2013. Anyone starting an Apprenticeship after this date needs to give permission for their training provider to apply for their completion certificate, on their behalf. In addition to this the apprentice needs to give permission for their data to be used in accordance with the [Data Use and Data Management Policy](#). From this date, all training providers must use the revised Apprentice Learning Agreement (ALA) form.

The Certifying Authority¹ requires that the declarations below must be completed and signed by the third party facilitating the certificate completion claim. The completed form, and all other supporting achievement evidence, as per the specific framework requirements, must be uploaded to the Apprenticeship Certificates Wales (ACW) system as part of the claim process.
