INTRODUCTION

In addition to the details within SASW, the following sections of this guidance document provide further clarity regarding the discretion that the Certifying Authority have in accepting qualifications for the English and Maths requirements of SASW Apprenticeships.

Following discussions with Welsh Government officials, they have confirmed that they are content for the Certifying Authority to use their discretion to accept regulated qualifications that are equivalent, or higher, than those stated in SASW for English and Maths. This means that qualifications that were previously unacceptable as part of a SASW framework completion, can now be used at the discretion of the relevant Certifying Authority.

Please note, however, that there are currently **no proxies for Digital Literacy** and the list of acceptable qualifications remains unchanged.

The following guidance lists the current list of acceptable SASW qualifications and those that can be used at the discretion of the Certifying Authority.

HIGHER APPRENTICESHIP (Level 4-7)

Generally, Essential Skill requirements for a Higher Apprenticeship are the same as those for at Apprenticeship Level 3.

However, as these are **minimum** SASW requirements, please refer to each framework document to confirm if achievement at a **higher level** has been specified by the sector.

Where a framework states requirement for **ESW at Level 3**, the Welsh Government have agreed that we can accept an A/AS Level (in the appropriate subject) at minimum Grade E, as an acceptable proxy.
